名 AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION ON THE PROMOTION OF INVESTMENTS 稱: BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA (AD.1991.11.15) (民國 80年11月15日簽訂)

## 1 PREAMBLE:

The Government of the Republic of China, hereafter referred to as the R.O.C., and the Government of the Republic of South Africa, hereafter referred to as the R.S.A., in the desire to create more favorable conditions for:

greater economic cooperation and mutual benefit of companies and residents of the R.O.C, and the R.S.A. when investing in each other's country. For this purpose, the two Governments have concluded the following:

## AGREEMENT:

- 1. The Government of R.O.C. and the Government of R.S.A. will each take the necessary steps to exchange information on the investment environment and incentives of both countries and this information will be made available to potential investors in their respective countries.
- 2. The Government of R.O.C. and the Government of R.S.A. will take all measures possible to maintain and improve the investment climate in their respective countries.
- 3. The Government of R.O.C. and the Government of R.S.A. will promote the facilitation of two-way investment.
- 4. The Government of R.O.C. and the Government of R.S.A. will form a working committee which will meet as and when required. Both countries will assign personnel to meet alternately in the R.O.C. and the R.S.A. for suitable periods to explore possibilities of closer cooperation and areas of technology transfer.
- 5. The Government of R.O.C. and the Government of R.S.A. shall not be held liable, while facilitating and promoting investment in each other's country for any decision made by private, legal entities or persons to invest in each other's country
